Deliver of Controlled Substance or Marijuana to a minor

Drug Paraphernalia

The delivery of a controlled substance (one from Groups 1-3; see Appendix) or marijuana to a minor (a person 17 or under who is in elementary or secondary school) is punishable by 5-99 years imprisonment and a fine of \$20,000 or less.
