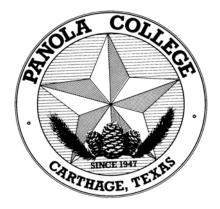

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#### Administrator's Statement

Panola College respectfully supports the \$2.03 billion formula funding request submitted by the Texas Association of Community Colleges (TACC) in its letter to the Legislative Budget Board and the Governor's Office, Budget Division. State support remains critical to the district as it continues to fulfill its statutory role and mission to offer vocational, technical, and academic courses for certificate, transfer and degree programs. Together with Texas' other 49 community college districts, we will continue to do much of the heavy lifting in the state's efforts to achieve the Building a Talent Strong Texas strategic plan. Expanded state investments in community colleges will support dual credit courses that give high school students an early start in postsecondary education; initiatives to recruit uncredentialed Texans and support them through graduation; and the creation and expansion of programs built on the skills necessary for gainful employment and Texas' continued economic growth.
