**Notes and Comments from SFA**

After acceptance to SFA, students must apply for the Link-Ed Distance Online Program.

A maximum of 66 hours of academic courses plus up to 4 hours of PHED/KINE courses, totaling 70 hours, from community colleges can be applied in a bachelor's degree.

If a student is Core Complete at Panola College, they are Core Complete at SFA. If Core is not complete at Panola College, core must be completed using SFA's requirements.

Students will be required to repeat pre-requisite courses when the grade is below a C. A minimum of 50 hours of work must be completed at SFA. Fall and spring semesters offer courses in a 16-week format, with select courses also available in a 8-week format in the summer only.
