EKG Technician Program

Registration Requirements:

- Apply online panola.edu/admissions
- Dual Credit/Early Admissions Form
- Driver's License or State ID
- Social Security Card
- High School Diploma or GED required for national testing

The course will include important practice and background information on anatomy and physiology of the heart, medical disease processes, medical terminology, medical ethics, legal aspects of patient contact, and electrocardiography and stress testing. Additionally, the student will practice with EKG equipment and perform hands-on labs including introduction to the function and proper use of the EKG machine, normal anatomy of the chest wall for proper lead placement, 12-lead placement, and other clinical practices.

Upon completion of the course, the student will register for the National Workforce Career Association Certified EKG Technician Exam. The fee for this exam is \$99. High school students passing the exam will receive a provisional certificate until diploma is received.
