Phlebotomy Certificate Program

Phlebotomy I:	90 Classroom hours	
Phlebotomy II:	150 Clinical hours	
CPR (BLS):	Due before CPR	Cost: \$65
AMT Testing Fee:	Due at end of Session II	Cost: \$125

Registration Requirements:

- Driver's License or State ID
- Social Security Card
- Criminal Background Check and Drug Screening
- Proof of Immunizations

Students must take and pass both sections to complete the course. These courses will provide 90 hours of classroom lecture and 150 hours of on-site clinical training. Prior to the clinical portion of the program, students **must** have certification in BLS for Health Care Provider CPR, proof of the immunizations listed below and a negative TB test.

After successful completion of the 240 hours, students will register for the state certification exam through American Medical Technologists (AMT). Once the students are registered for the exam, they may set up their exam date at their convenience. **The students are responsible for the cost of the exam (\$125.00).** This amount will be paid to Panola College.

Students must provide proof of the following immunizations prior to clinical training of the program:

- Varicella
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Hepatitis B vaccine
- Tetanus/Diphtheria (within 10 years)
- Influenza (within 1 year, cannot expire during clinicals)
- Negative TB skin test/chest x-ray (within the last year)

Please do NOT give your instructor original documents. Students should provide copies and keep the originals.
