# Panola College, Carthage, Texas

Panola College is a thriving and award-winning community college located in Carthage, Texas. The name derives from Panola County, Texas, of which Carthage is the county seat.

In just more than 75 years, Panola College has grown in both size and in the scope of its services offered to its students and its community. The school, which was established in 1947, was created to provide young people with the opportunity to earn the first two years of a traditional baccalaureate. The services the College offers have expanded greatly to meet community needs, providing a wide range of educational and training opportunities to citizens of all ages.

The College began operating temporary buildings before the first two permanent buildings were erected in 1949. A 35-acre campus at the junction of Texas state Highway 315 and U.S. 79 in Carthage has been the school's home since its inception. There are now nineteen permanent buildings with more than 135 acres available for expansion in the coming century.

In addition to a comprehensive community college in Carthage, the school offers a variety of instructional opportunities in a four-county service area including Harrison, Marion, and Shelby counties.

These three counties became part of the college's official service area by legislative act in 1995.

Enrollment at the College has grown from fewer than 100 students at the first registration in January of 1948 to over 2,600. The College provides many services, which enrich the lives of individuals in the region.


In 1998 Panola College requested authority to offer distance learning classes and presently offers several distance learning degrees.

# General Information

## UIL Academic Headquarters

The Academic UIL Headquarters is located in the Elizabeth R. Hedges Studio Theatre. This is found in the annex of Q. M. Martin Building. Holding area for UIL Academic competitors will be in the Ross Ballroom found in Charles Matthews Student Center. The Speech/ Debate tab room and judge holding area is located on the stage of Q. M. Martin Auditorium. Students may not be on the stage. Speech / Debate coaches and competitors may sit in the house of Q. M. Martin Auditorium. No food or drinks in this space.

## Participant Requirements

### **Panola College has a few requirements that we ask our participants to follow:**

- The designated administrator of each school who has qualified representative is responsible for knowing the dates for the meet and the scheduled time for each contest or event. All events will start exactly the time posted. A roll call will be taken for each contest or event. Participants will –NOT- be allowed to enter the contest after the contest has begun.
- Each school must follow the Spring Meet Code as outlined in this handbook and the Constitution and Contest Rules of the University Interscholastic League, which encourages all participants to compete in all contest in the spirit of fairness, good sportsmanship and high ethics. Graders from school coaches are encouraged to participate in order to help facilitate the contest. The C&CR states the conditions in which coaches may assist in grading for contests.
- Participants should accept decision of officials or judges, treat officials with respect, treat opponents as guests and should put sportsmanship above victory. Violation of the code may result in probation, disqualification, or suspension of participants and /or schools.
- Coaches and Sponsors are responsible for the safety and conduct of their students. Please respect the Panola College facilities while on campus.

## Registration



One coach per school is asked to register upon arrival to campus. This will take place at Academic UIL Headquarters. Located in the Elizabeth R. Hedges Studio Theatre, found in the annex of Q. M. Martin Building.

You will receive updated schedules with room numbers, maps and other pertinent information in your packet. If your school purchased meal vouchers, they will be in your packet.

## Absent Contestants

A list of absent contestants will be reported to the State UIL office from each academic event if prior notification was not given.

## Academic Conflicts

If a student who has not followed the State Conflict Pattern earns eligibility to compete at the region level in more than one event and finds that he/she has a full or partial conflict in the two events, he/she must make a choice of which contest will be participated. No adjustments will be considered to accommodate the conflict if the State Conflict Pattern was not followed at the district level. Following the Conflict Pattern at Region is mandated by UIL.

## Awards

After results are verified, medals should be picked up from Elizabeth R. Hedges Studio Theatre. **All medals should be picked up by schools before leaving campus. Medals must be picked up by an adult representative of the school.** Students may not pick up awards. **NO awards or materials will be mailed.** The region will not be responsible for mailing unclaimed awards.

## Bus Parking

Busses should park in the Q. M. Martin Auditorium parking lot or in front of Sid B. Turner Memorial Chapel.

## Computers

**No computers will be provided by the regional site.** All events that require or allow a computer / printer, must be provided by the individual school as well as other resources such as power strips, copy stands, paper etc.

In events where computers and printers are used, it is the responsibility of each student to ensure the equipment is working properly and that there are enough electrical cords. Computers must be setup and ready to use when the contest begins. Printing must have started by the end of the contest time. Sponsors will not be allowed to assist students if the equipment malfunctions during the contest and extra time will not be allotted.

## Communication: Group Me and BAND Apps.

The GROUP ME App will be used for communication. It is asked that only school adult representatives subscribe to the group.

The code to sign up is **2A, R3 ACADEMICS**.

For speech / debate there will be an additional Group Me or BAND app. Coaches, judges and competitors will receive that login information the morning of the contest, Friday, April 24, 2026.

## Contest Assistants

All coaches are asked to check in with the contest director the day of the meet to offer assistance in monitoring the contest.

## Day of Procedures

Competitors and sponsors should report to contest rooms 15 minutes prior to the contest so that the events may start on time. Please note that when technology is used, it must be ready at the beginning of the contest time. Therefore in those events, contestants may want to arrive more than 15 minutes early.

## Dining

There will not be a hospitality room for coaches.

Panola College Café is open from 7:30-9:00 (breakfast) and 11:30-1:30 (lunch).

Also open on campus is CHARLIE'S BISTRO and Coffee Shop serving Starbucks! Charlie's Bistro is located in the lobby of A. Johnson Gym, next to the Student Center. They offer a variety of snack bar type offerings. Open from 7:30-2:00.

*It is against Panola College policy to bring outside food into the Charles Matthews Student Center. Schools should not place group orders (such as Pizza) and bring it into the Matthews Student Center.*

## Eligibility

The eligibility of each student competing at the Regional Meet is the responsibility of the individual school he or she is representing.

## Entry Changes, Alternates and Team Substitutions

Each District Chairperson must certify the district results. The correct and full names not initials, of the contestants must be given. The first and second alternates must be notified that if one or two of the qualifiers cannot make the meet, the alternate(s) will be able to compete at the Regional Meet. If a school has any changes in its entries after they have been submitted, both the District Chairperson and the Regional Meet Director must be informed in writing prior to the day of the contest. Any team substitute, as allowed by the C&CR, must present a completed substitution form or a letter of eligibility signed by the designated school administrator. Any questions about entries or changes should be sent to Kimberley Funderburk at [kfunderburk@panola.edu](mailto:kfunderburk@panola.edu).

## Grading

Grading will happen immediately following each contest. Rooms will be designated on the schedule for each contests' grading area. All available coaches are asked to assist with grading. **Please note that SPELLING –REQUIRES- a grader from all participating schools.**

## Late Arrival

When a student is not present at roll call, he/she may be replaced by an alternate. Once an alternate has replaced a student in roll call, a substitution WILL NOT be made. A student who arrives after the contest has begun will not be permitted to compete, even if no alternate has replaced him/her.

## Registration

Academic results are submitted through the UIL Spring Meet (Speech Wire) online system. No other contestant registration is necessary for the regional meet.

## Special Accommodations
